

English



We will be looking at the fiction text The Barnabas Project and Journey. Our English work in class will be focused around forming a simple sentence and beginning to write it down. You can help at home by:

- Practicing name writing at home.
- Writing simple captions and labels.
- Practice forming a sentence orally.
- Practice writing a simple caption or sentence.
- Begin to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Science

We will be looking at seasonal changes (Summer to Autumn), This is Me (how am growing) and our Five Senses. You can help by talking about the weather and going on a walk and using your senses to see what you experience.



P.E

This term, the children will be learning some fitness games and developing their football skills.

PSHE

We will be using The Story Project and the text 'The Friendship Bench' to explore the themes of friendship, moving away, new beginning, resilience and starting school.

Maths

Our Maths work in class will be focused around exploring numbers to 10.



You can help at home by:

- Helping your child to recognise the numbers 0 to 10 and spot numbers when you are out and about.
- Whilst playing games at home, or at any appropriate opportunity, encourage your child to count in a stable order, with 1:1 correspondence.

Year 1

Computing

We will be learning how to stay safe online and learning the importance of passwords. The children will be developing their mouse skills and how to use different computing systems and networks. You can help by talking about the importance of having limits on screen time and how to stay safe online.



Phonics

This term, the children will be revisiting phase four to embed the knowledge of the different graphemes they learnt in Reception. They will learn to read and spell words using cluster blends, suffixes and prefixes.

History

We are trying to answer the question: What is special about Lidget Green? We will be learning about the history of local area and how it has changed. You can help at home by:

- Listening to the story online: search Adoette by Lydia Monks on YouTube.
- Talking to your child about Lidget Green. Did you attend Lidget Green Primary as a child yourself? Do you have any memories of the local area? How has the local area changed?
- Go on a walk around Lidget Green and spot any local landmarks.

Art

The artist we will be looking at is a local artist: Jacky Al-Samarraie. You can help at home by:
