

Curriculum

Our history enquiry question is 'How has nursing changed over time?'

We will learn about Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole to understand how nursing has changed, why these changes were made and the contributions these nurses made in the past.

How you can help at home:

Talk about what your child has learned. Carry out research using books and the internet to find out information. Compare what hospitals were like then and the kind of facilities we have now.

Maths

In Maths, we are looking at multiplication and division. We will learn to multiply and divide numbers using groups and arrays.

How you can help at home:

- Recall the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables and related division facts so they can become times tables champions



- Scan the QR code to play the interactive maths game 'Hit the Button' – The games, which are against the clock, challenge and develop a child's mental maths skills.

Science

Our Science topic this half term is healthy eating, exercise and diet. The children will be learning about healthy eating, the importance of breaks and rest and hygiene.

How you can help at home:

Discuss whether a plate of food has all the nutrition we need. Remind your children about the benefits of rest and hygiene in their daily routines.

How to help at home



Year 2

English

In English, we will be writing a diary entry based on a fictional character's experiences using the book 'Dougal's Deep Sea Diary'. We will be using conjunctions to extend our sentences as well as making sure we use good punctuation and spellings.

Computing

Our online safety topic is 'Online Reputation.' The children will be learning about how information we put online can stay there for a long time and why we must think about what we put online. They will also learn how to raise concerns if they put something on by mistake.

Alongside this, we will be looking at computing systems and networks and we will be learning about word processing.

Art

In art, the children will learn how to mix primary colours, create lighter and darker shades, and explore texture using different tools. They will use these skills to produce a landscape collage.

P.E

In P.E, the children will learn the skills needed to play basketball. They will also be learning how to control their bodies during gymnastics.
