

Communication and Language

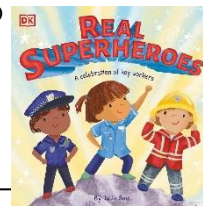
Key vocabulary:

- A Super Hero Like You
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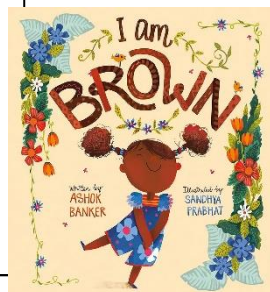


Reading to your child is so important. Share stories and information books with your child and talk about them. Can you read books about super heroes and people who help us like police, fire fighters, doctors and teachers?

Physical Development

We will continue to develop our fine and gross motor skills indoors and outdoors. We will explore activities to develop fine-motor, muscles in fingers and our pencil grip. We will also develop our confidence in moving our bodies in variety of ways.

Understanding The World

Past and present- We will be reflecting on changes in our lifetime, such as how we used to be a baby as well as events in our school year so far.

The Natural World- We will learn about our bodies and caring for our teeth. We will learn about our senses. We will continue to notice changes in the season as we head into Summer.

Maths we will be:

- Comparing more and less, counting amounts, ordering numerals to 5, Building and splitting numbers in different ways, developing an in-depth understanding of which number comes next 1-5, Developing an in-depth understanding of which number comes before 0-5, Consolidating and securing the understanding of the numbers 1-5. **Please practice numbers to 5 at home**

Expressive arts: Our Artist Inspiration this half term is Claud Monet.

Songs: Miss Molly Had a Dolly, Jack and Jill, what will I be when I grow up?

Sing or listen to nursery rhymes with your child and ask them to do the actions.
