

English

In Year 6 English this half term, pupils will write a persuasive letter inspired by *The Loving Earth*, using emotive language, rhetorical questions, formal tone, modal verbs and clear paragraphing to present a balanced argument. They will then move on to writing a biography about Bruce Lee, focusing on chronological structure, formal language, third person, expanded noun phrases, relative clauses and cohesive devices to organise facts clearly and effectively.

Reading

As part of Sats revision and preparation for Sats tests, Year 6 children are reading unseen Fiction and Non-Fiction texts and answering comprehension questions. The children will develop strategies to answer retrieval, vocabulary, prediction, inference and summarising questions.

PSHE



In PSHE this half term, Year 6 will study *Sunny Side Up* in *The Story Project*. As part of Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE), the story helps pupils explore feelings, friendships, and how to handle challenges. It encourages them to think about empathy, resilience, and making positive choices. 😊📖



Maths

In Year 6 maths this half term, pupils will develop their understanding of area and perimeter, learning to calculate the area of different shapes and solve related problems. They will also study statistics, interpreting and presenting data using line graphs and pie charts, and solving problems involving averages.



Topic

In History this half term, students will learn about how the religion of Islam began with the Prophet Muhammad in Mecca. They also study the Islamic Golden Age, when scholars made important advances in science, medicine, and mathematics that influenced the world.



How to help at home Year 6 Spring Term



R.E

This term in RE, students will explore why suffering exists, linking creation stories and free will to human choices, and examining religious and non-religious responses, including prayer and reflection.

Spanish

This term in Spanish, students will practise their pronunciation, including recognising which part of a word is stressed. They will build simple phrases using prepositions and learn how to ask and answer questions about prices. Pupils will listen for key information in conversations and use useful phrases to take part in a shopping role play. **ESPAÑOL**

Computing

In Year 6 computing this half term, pupils will develop their programming skills through an introduction to Python, learning to write, debug and refine simple programs. They will also continue to deepen their understanding of online safety, focusing on responsible use, privacy and recognising potential risks online.



P.E

In cricket, Year 6 will develop batting, bowling and fielding skills, focusing on accuracy, control and teamwork. In volleyball, they will refine serving, setting and digging, improving consistency and positioning. In both, pupils will apply simple tactics and evaluate performances to improve.
