Our behaviour principles:

Rehearsed 3- word routines in classes	Restorative approaches (not shouting, private)	Daily meet and greets	Recognition boards

Every behaviour intervention, positive or corrective, must be punctuated with Ready, Respectful and Safe

Lidget Green's consequence steps
<p>1. Supportive Reminder</p> <p>Reminder of three simple rules (Ready, respectful and safe). Delivered privately where possible.</p> <p>Was that being ready? Was that being respectful? Was that safe?</p>
<p>2. Warning</p> <p>Clear verbal caution delivered privately where possible, making the pupil aware of their behaviour and outlining the consequences if they continue. Teacher discreetly records conversation in the Class Coaching record/ book as a 1, 2 or 3 (according to the rule broken)</p>
<p>3. Last chance + Time out</p> <p>Few minutes for the child to calm down, breathe, and look at the situation from a different perspective. In the calm zone in the classroom.</p>
<p>4. Triage (Referral to SLT)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Self regulating space Opportunity to talk, access support and reset Quiet place to study
<p>5. 'Pick up your own tab'- Teachers choice and Repair</p> <p>Quick catch-up, restorative conversation, imposition or natural consequence.</p>

Serious Breaches

Students who commit a serious breach will be triaged immediately without support steps. This might include:

Bullying	Racist Language	Sexualised Language or harassment
Violence	Homophobic Behaviour	Possession of banned items
