This leaflet contains details of the menu at Lidget Green after the Easter Holidays.

Tasty, nutritious school meals have been provided in the Bradford district for many years.

The Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme means these meals are provided FREE to all primary school children in reception class and Years 1 & 2.

There are no forms to fill in, or other elegibility criteria. So if your child is in one of these year groups, you can simply send them along to school to enjoy a delicious free lunch each day. If you would be eligible for free school meals (see criteria overleaf), it's important that you still register as your school will benefit from extra funding.

Please Note: For children in Years 3-6, meals will be priced at £1.80, which is still great value for money.

You can scroll through the menu options for each day, look at nutritional and allergen information, save your child's school, and so much more!! Children in Years 3 to 6 could also get School Meals for FREE

Your child is entitled to free school meals if you receive any of the following^V:

- Income Support Universal Credit
- Income based Jobseekers Allowance
- Child Tax Credit with an annual income of less than £16,190, if not receiving Working Tax Credit • Income-related Employment and
- Working Tax Credit run-on

- Pension Credit (Guarantee Credit only)
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Support Allowance
