

# Nursery Homework Activities

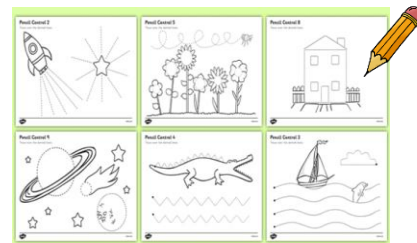
Draw a picture of your family. Make sure you add details e.g. eyes, nose, mouth, arms and legs.



Read your library reading book and talk about the characters and the main events in the story.

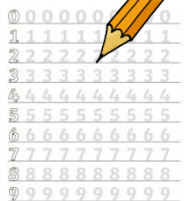


Practise writing your name at home and completing the pencil control worksheets.
