<p>Draw a picture of a character from your class text, reading book or library book. Write a character description using descriptive language.</p>	<p>Task 1 - Read your reading book and write a book review. Task 2 - Write some questions for your grownups to answer.</p>	<p>Find out what your family and friend's favourite colour is and then create a bar chart to show your results. Write some questions for your friends to answer.</p> 
<p>Generate some 4-6 digits numbers and add them using column addition. Then, generate some 4-6 digits numbers and subtract them using column subtraction.</p> <p>Now, create a poster with the rules for how we can add and subtract. </p>	<p>Think about your reading book. Where is the story set? Write a setting description using descriptive language. Don't forget to use your 5 senses!</p>	<p>Task 1- Practise your spellings and put them into sentences. Task 2- Create a wordsearch including your new spellings. Task 3- Test yourself</p> <p>What other fun and exciting ways can you practise your spellings?</p>
<p>Complete your reading comprehension.</p> <p>Remember to use the strategies learnt in class, when answering your questions.</p>	<p>Generate some 3-6 digits numbers and multiply them by a 1 or 2-digit number using the written method used in class. Then, generate some 3-4 digits numbers and divide them by 1 digit numbers using the written method used in class.</p> <p>Now, create a poster with the rules for how we can multiply and divide numbers.</p>	<p>While you are at home, write a diary entry every night. Make sure you include your thoughts, feelings and emotions. You might want to add some illustrations.</p> 
<p>You are an author. Write an adventure story. You can plan your story on a story mountain first. Make sure you add some dialogue!</p>	<p>Design a new front cover and write a blurb to go with it</p> 	<p>Find some objects in your house. Measure them with a ruler/tape measure. Write down the measurement. How many different ways can you record the measurement - using different units of measure.</p>
