## Year 4 Homework activities

Draw a picture of a character from your class text, reading book or library book. Write a character description using descriptive language.

Task I - Read your reading book and write a book review.

Task 2 - Write some questions for your grownups to answer. Find out what your family and friend's favourite colour is and then create a bar chart to show your results.

Write some questions for your friends to answer.



Generate some 4-6 digits numbers and **add** them using column addition. Then, generate some 4-6 digits numbers and **subtract** them using column subtraction.

Now, create a poster with the rules for how we can add and subtract.

Think about your reading book. Where is the story set? Write a setting description using descriptive language. Don't forget to use your 5 senses!

Task 1- Practise your spellings and put them into sentences.

Task 2- Create a wordsearch including your new spellings.

Task 3- Test yourself

What other fun and exciting ways can you practise your spellings?

Complete your reading comprehension.

Remember to use the strategies learnt in class, when answering your questions.

Generate some 3-6 digits numbers and multiply them by a I or 2-digit number using the written method used in class. Then, generate some 3-4 digits numbers and divide them by I digit numbers using the written method used in class.

Now, create a poster with the rules for how we can multiply and divide numbers. While you are at home, write a diary entry every night.
Make sure you include your thoughts, feelings and emotions.
