Phonics- We will begin Little Wandle Phonics this half term. Please bring your child's book bag to school every day and practice their reading book at home with them. Please attend the Early Phonics and reading showcase at 9am 15th of October.

Understanding The World - People, Culture and Communities- Learning about the immediate area where we live in Lidget Green, Bradford and naming familiar landmarks. We will find our school and street on a map and begin to make simple maps. We will explore the school grounds. We will discuss about our families and extended families. Find out about people who help us in school. Past and Present- Reflecting on our personal history and

understanding that people born before us are older. We will begin to learn about the idea of a timeline which will show our time in Reception-past, present and future. The Natural World we will learn about growth and changes in the human body. Learning about healthy eating and how the body works. introduce toothbrushing and why / how we take care of our teeth. Name and sort some materials as part of routines e.g. metal/plastic containers in the water tray. Please send in a picture of your child when they were a baby and one of your family to support our learning. We look forward to sharing these pictures in class.

Expressive arts: Our Artist inspiration this half term is Bradford born David Hockey's "Portrait of Mum". We will focus on Learning how to use the creative areas and create a Reception book-This is How we...paint/ wear an apron, use painting tools. (In the creative area). This is how we use resources in the workshop area (glue, scissors, collages materials, junk modelling. We will also be **u**sing a variety of materials to make faces and sketching self portaits and drawings of our family.

Music- we will begin class music sessions and learn about timbre, beat, pitch contour and musical story telling. We will learn soungs as part of our routines as well as 'Heads Shoulders Knees and Toes'. Sing or listen to nursery rhymes with your child and ask them to do the actions. Encourage your child to sing some of the songs they sing at school for you and celebrate artwork they bring home.
